

Terms & Conditions

(effective from 1st of April 2026)

1. SCOPE OF APPLICATION

1.1.

These Terms and Conditions are applicable to the sale of conference fees for events, specifically the Vienna Aviation Days 2026 ("VAD26"), which are offered and sold via the website <https://exfan-project.eu/vienna-aviation-days-2026>. VAD26 is an event organized by Advanced Drivetrain Technologies GmbH as part of the European project exFan (101138184). The VAD26 will take place on June 23rd and 24th, 2026.

1.2.

The contract partner for all purchases on conference fees for the VAD26 is Advanced Drivetrain Technologies GmbH (UID Nr.: ATU78220113) located in Leonard-Bernstein-Straße 8/2/1, 1220 Wien, Austria ("Host").

1.3.

1.3.1.

The Terms and Conditions are applicable if the buyer ("Customer") is a consumer as defined in Section 1 KSchG (Consumer Protection Act) and a private person.

1.3.2.

If the buyer is a business entity ("Business Customer") as defined in Section 1 to 3 UGB (Austrian Commercial Code), certain clauses will specify different provisions applicable to such customers.

2. PRICES

2.1.

All prices listed for the conference fees are expressed in euros and include 20% VAT. The prices are for one person attending the conference.

2.2.

The conference fee is divided into the following categories:

- Standard Conference Fee
- Reduced Conference Fee
- Student Conference Fee
- Support Conference Fee

2.2.1.

The "Standard Conference Fee" is for business customers that will attend the VAD26.

2.2.2.

The „Reduced Conference Fee“ is for customers and private persons according to these Terms & Conditions. The customer must state his reason of interest in the VAD26 in the provided comment field and click the checkbox "I confirm that I am purchasing this Conference Fee as a private person and am not acting on behalf of a company".

The Host wants to provide access to the VAD26 for every interested person with a smaller fee and therefore asks for justification in form of a short comment and the checkbox.

The Host reserves the right to check this justification and accept the Order afterwards.

In the event of misuse, the difference between the "Reduced Conference Fee" and the "Standard Conference Fee" may be charged. There is no legal entitlement to the purchase of a "Reduced Conference Fee".

or as a student their ongoing studies and student ID.

2.2.3.

The „Student Conference Fee“ is for customers according to these Terms & Conditions that are currently pursuing a technical study related to the subject of the VAD26 and are no older than 30 years. The student must state his studies, student ID and reason of interest in the VAD26 in the provided comment field. The checkbox "I confirm that I am purchasing this Conference Fee as a private person and am not acting on behalf of a company" also has to be checked.

The Host wants to provide access to the VAD26 for interested students with no fee and therefore asks for justification in form of a short comment and the checkbox.

The Host reserves the right to check this justification and accept the Order afterwards.

In the event of misuse, the difference between the "Student Conference Fee" and the "Standard Conference Fee" may be charged. There is no legal entitlement to the purchase of a "Student Conference Fee".

2.2.4.

The "Support Conference Fee" is for customers or business customers who want to support the organisation of the VAD26 with an additional charge of EUR 100,-. With this additional charge, the Host can provide the participation of more interested students and private persons, which enhances the inclusion of the next generation. The future is them and the Host wants to give students the opportunity to participate and learn.

3. ORDER PROCESS AND CONFIRMATION

3.1.

The ordering process is as follows:

- Enter your personal information
- Select the desired conference fee and the number of days you will attend the conference
- Review and, if necessary, correct the order
- Confirm that you have read and accepted the Terms & Conditions and Privacy Policy
- Submit a binding order by clicking "Place an order"

3.2.

The customer or business customer must ensure that all information provided in connection with the order is accurate, correct and up to date. Any changes to this information must be reported to the Host immediately.

3.3.

The conference fees displayed on the website represent an invitation to the customer or business customer to submit a binding offer to the Host for the purchase of conference fees ("Order"). The Order is submitted to the Host in a binding manner by clicking on the button "Place an order". The customer or business customer hereby agrees that he is agreeing to place an order with an obligation to pay.

3.4.

Once the customer or business customer has successfully submitted a binding order to the Host, the Host will send a confirmation to the email address provided by the customer or business customer.

3.4.1.

For the purchase of "Reduced Conference Fee" and "Student Fee", the confirmation e-mail does not constitute an acceptance of the Order by the Host. By receiving the order confirmation, the customer is simply notified that the Host has received the order.

The Host reserves the right to verify whether the customer is attending the VAD26 as a private person or Student by analysing the justification provided by the customer in the comment field of the Registration Form.

The Host then accepts the Order by sending another e-mail with the payment request.

3.4.2.

For the purchase of "Standard Conference Fee" and "Support Conference Fee", the confirmation email will state the acceptance of the Order.

4. TERMS OF PAYMENT

Orders can only be paid by invoice. The customer or business customer will receive the invoice from the Host on the email they provided in the Registration Form.

The invoice amount must be paid within 14 days of receiving the invoice. Payment must be made to the Host's bank account which is specified on the invoice. Any exchange rate differences between other currencies and the euro shall be paid by the customer or business customer.

5. TERMS OF DELIVERY

The customer or business customer will receive the QR code for access to the location of the VAD26 7 days prior to the event, on June 16th, 2026. The Host will send the QR code to the email address provided by the customer or corporate customer. The customer or business customer will receive the QR code only if the invoice has been settled.

6. WARRANTY

The Host provides a warranty in accordance with applicable law. If a customer or business customer wants to file a complaint, it should be sent to monika.thaller@adt-engineering.at.

The Host is not liable for the actuality, accuracy, or completeness of the event content and materials, or for the conduct of the event.

7. DEFAULT OF PAYMENT OF THE CUSTOMER/BUSINESS CUSTOMER

If the customer or business customer has not paid the invoice amount by the end of the payment period (14 days), the Host will grant a further period of 7 days for payment. If the customer or business customer has still not paid the invoice amount within this additional period, the Host may withdraw from the contract.

8. DEFAULT OF THE HOST

If the Host fails to deliver at the agreed time, the customer or business customer may request the Host to fulfil the obligation within a further period of 7 days. If the Host fails to deliver within this period, the customer or business customer may withdraw from the contract.

9. TERMINATION

9.1.

Customers are able to terminate the contract within 14 days of receiving the acceptance of order, without providing a reason.

9.2.

Business customers are able to terminate the contract within 7 days after receiving the payment request and invoice, but not later than June 9th, 2026.

9.3.

The right of termination expires in advance if the booked conference (VAD26) has taken place and the customer or business customer has participated in it.

9.4.

The notice of termination must be sent to the Host. The notice of termination is not subject to any formal requirements but must contain a clear statement regarding the decision to terminate (e.g., by email or a letter sent by mail). The customer or business customer may also use the following example notice of termination, although this is not required. To meet the termination deadline, it is sufficient to send the notice of termination before the deadline expires.

9.5.

All payments made will be refunded to the customer or business customer within 14 days after the termination notice was sent to the Host.

10. LIABILITY AND COMPENSATION

10.1.

The Hosts liability to customers for damages caused by slight negligence—excluding personal injury and material contractual obligations—is excluded. Liability is also excluded for pure financial losses, damages to third parties, loss of profits, and consequential damages. The Host is liable for damages caused by gross negligence or intentional misconduct.

10.2.

With respect to business customers, the Hosts liability is limited to damages caused by gross negligence or intentional misconduct. Liability is excluded for pure financial losses, damages to third parties, loss of profits, and consequential damages.

11. PLACE OF JURISDICTION

11.1.

Austrian law shall apply exclusively to the exclusion of the UN Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods. The place of jurisdiction is Vienna.

11.2.

For customers, this choice of law applies only to the extent that it does not deprive the customer of the protection afforded by mandatory provisions of the law of the country in which the customer has his habitual residence.

11.3.

The contract language is English.

12. GENERAL PROVISIONS

12.1.

The customer or business customer is required to notify the Host immediately of any changes to their personal information. If the Host is not notified of a change in the information, any notice sent by the provider to the last known mailing address or email address shall nevertheless be deemed to have been received by the customer.

12.2.

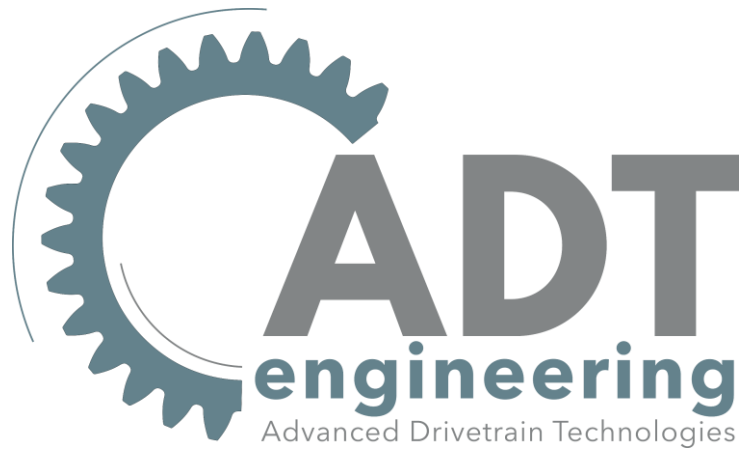
The Host reserves the right to, even at short notice, replace announced speakers with others and make necessary changes to the agenda while keeping the overall character of the conference. For significant and objectively justified reasons, the Host has the right to announce changes or deviation from the agenda of which the customer or business customer will be informed prior to the start of the VAD26.

12.3.

The venue's house rules and regulations are applicable.

12.4.

The Provider commits to treating the personal data and information of the Customer or business customer as confidential. The provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 are provided separately in the Privacy Policy.
